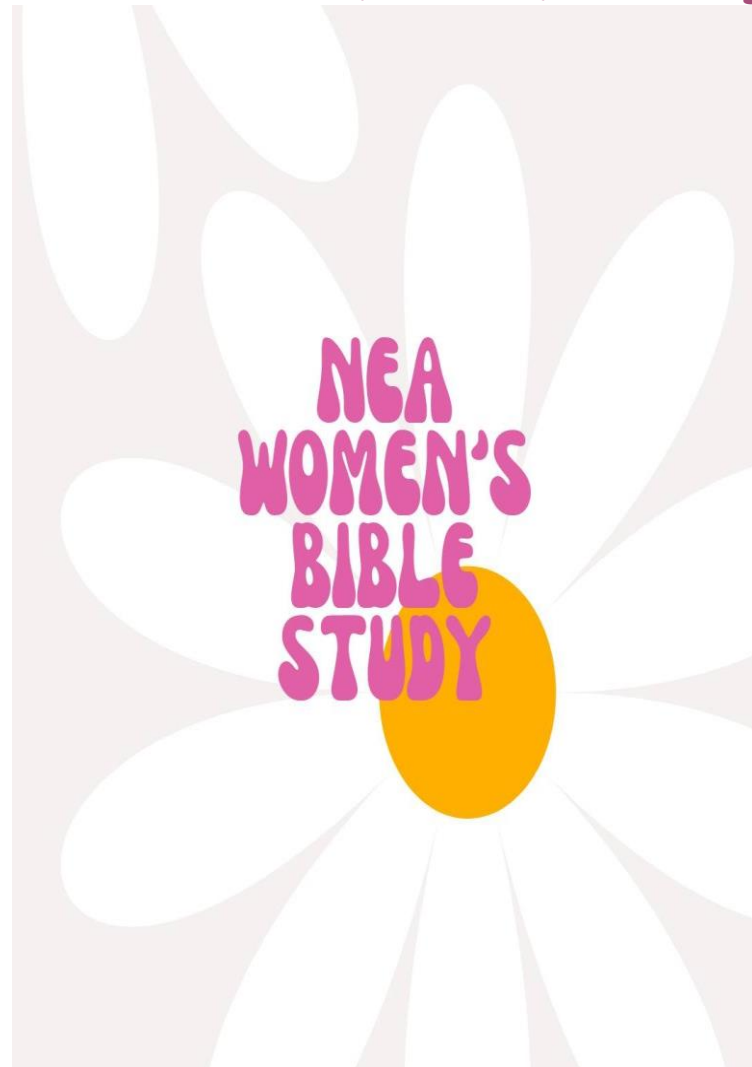


Saturday, June 17th, at 3 p.m., The NEA Women's Bible Study will be at Greensboro Road.
